- ALOHA site (refer to CIA.edu)
- Hit the streets



MEETING THE LANDLORD

- Make an appointment
- Prepare some questions
- Go with someone
- Take notes
- Bills, Bugs, and Building maintenance



THINGS TO ASK...

- Rent.. And when is it due?
- What utilities are included?
- How much are the utilities that are not?
- Regular exterminating?
- Lease terms (9,10,12 months)

- Restrictions on guests?
- # of occupants?
- Who do I call in an emergency?
- What if I lose my key?
- What are requirements for a full refund of my security deposit?

WHAT AM I LOOKING OUT FOR?

- Is it clean?
- Is it well maintained?
- Open cabinets (Look for critters)
- # of outlets
- Does hot water start right away?
- How available is the landlord/super?






- Pets?
- Security?
- Proper trash containers.
- Water damage
- Are the appliances in good shape
- Carpeting

THE LEASE

- Legal Document outlining you and your landlord obligations.
- It protects you and your landlord
- Defines length and terms.
- Make sure ALL TENANTS are on it

- If broken, the lease is no longer binding and offenders may be subject to legal action.
- You will need to pay..

- READ IT
- Have someone look it over who is not involved.
- Now is the time to ask for clarification and/or revisions.

- Plan
- Schedule a move in date
- Schedule a walkthrough prior
- Lock changes and when do you get your keys?
- Turning on utilities
- Who is going to help
- RENTERS INSURANCE

- Make sure that they are all on the lease
